Surveyed the above described tract of land containing one hundred and fifty acres and the usual allowance of six per cent for Alexander Mc Cutchen Sen^r. It being a part of a larger tract of land containing three hundred eleven acres and one hundred and two perches & allowance which was surveyed the 29th of April 1785 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Joseph Campbell bearing date the 30th of September 1784 Situate in Washington township on the main branch of Puckey up the creek in Westmoreland County.
