



Surveyed to Jacob & Elias Creighbaum the 23^d day of January A.D. 1838 on a warrant dated the 24th day of January 1837. containing 415 acres & 57 perches and the allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Situate on the waters of Wheeling Creek in Rich Hill Township in the County of Greene and State of Pennsylvania including a settlement and improvement. Called Fair View as appears from papers remaining filed in my office June the 18th 1841
