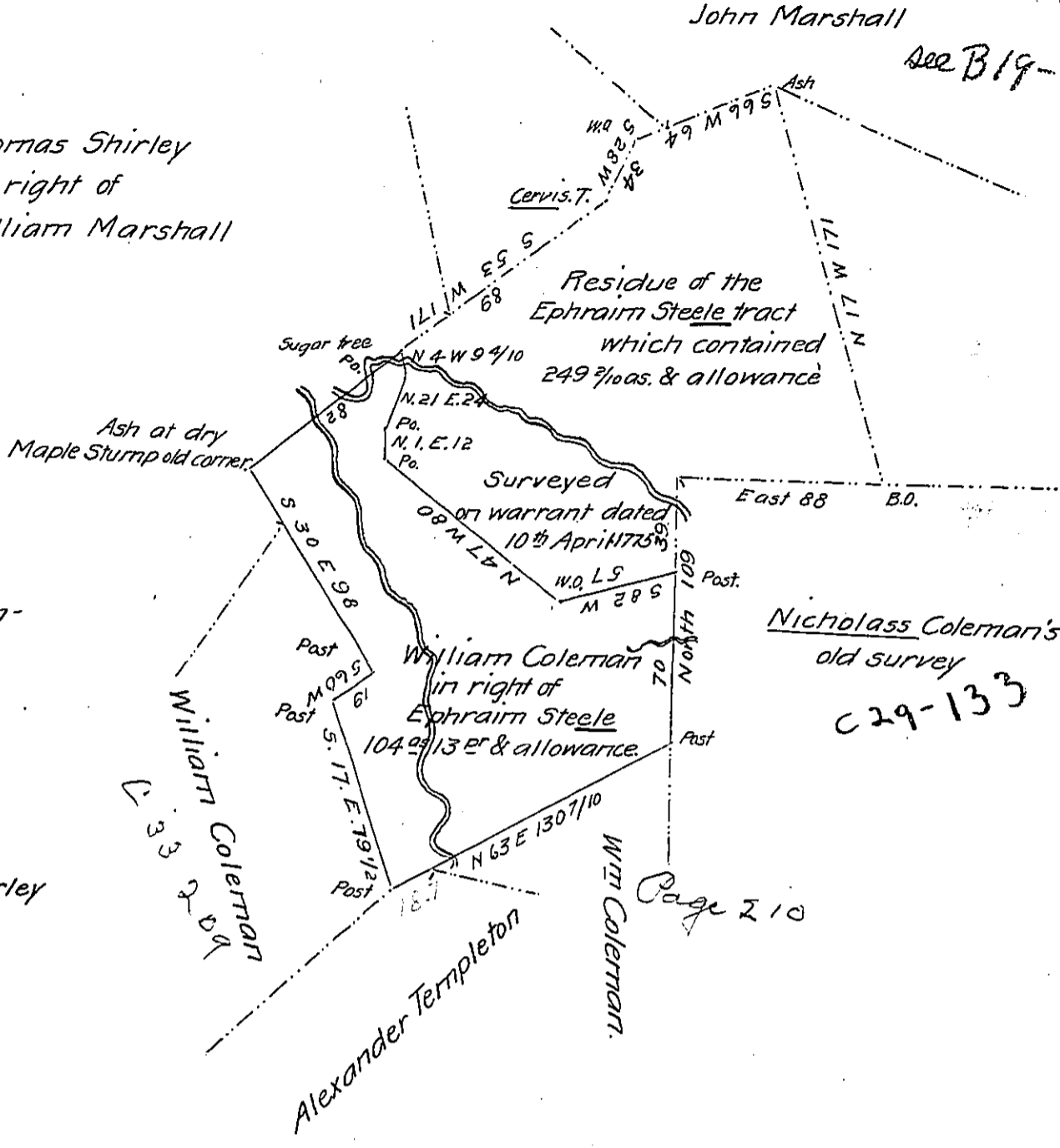

27th day of February A.D. 1849 Surveyed to William Coleman the above described piece of land containing one hundred and four acres and thirteen perches & allowance of six per cent. Situate in Conemaugh township Indiana County It being a part of a larger tract containing two hundred and forty nine acres and two tenths of an acre & allowance. Surveyed originally upon a warrant granted to Ephraim Steel dated the 10th day of April A.D. 1775.
