



Draft of two tracts of improved land situate in Canaan Township Wayne County, the one adjoining Isaac Smith Samuel Shaffer Thomas Blackledge and others containing one hundred and seventy five acres and eighty one perches and allowance of six per cent — and the other adjoining John Reeder Senr. at the forks of Middle Creek containing thirty acres and allowance of six per cent and containing altogether in the two said tracts two hundred and five acres and eighty one perches and allowance of six per cent. —

Surveyed the above described tracts of land the tenth day of January 1849 in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty nine for Jeremiah Curtis by virtue of two several warrants granted to Henry Curtis the 29<sup>th</sup> of <sup>August</sup> 1792, and reviewed the 16<sup>th</sup> day of October 1848 and to me directed

David S. West, D. Surveyor.
