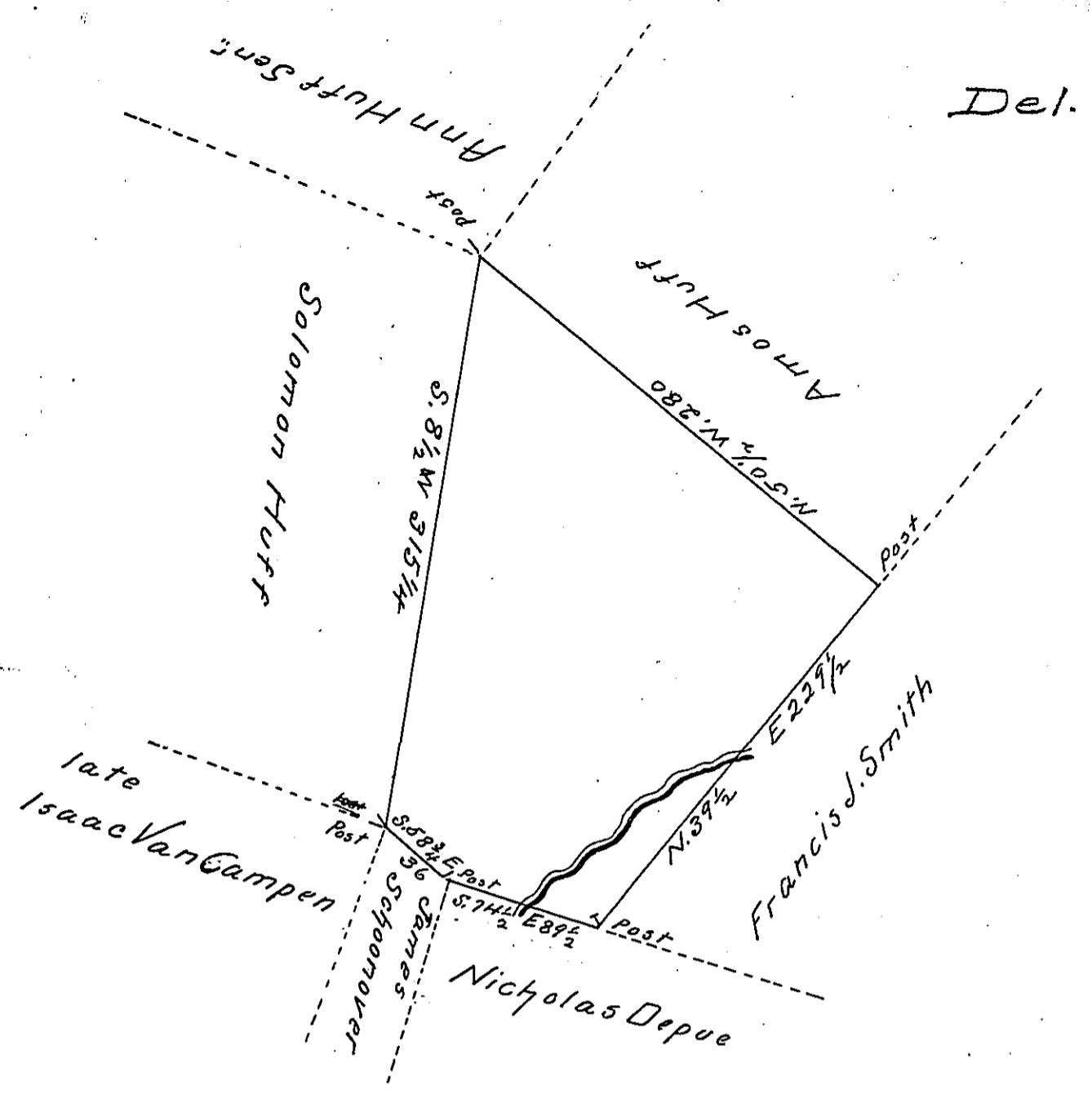


Del. - PIKE. ✓
