



A Draught of one hundred and sixteen acres and eighteen perches of land with 6<sup>pr</sup> cent. situate in Walker Township Juniata County. No. 1 appears to have been surveyed the 29<sup>th</sup> day of August 1795 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Joseph Cookson dated the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November 1786.

No. 2 is part of a tract surveyed in pursuance of a warrant to Jacob Yeigh Copied the above from Draughts remaining in the hands of the heirs of Christian Kauffman Dec<sup>d</sup> this 4<sup>th</sup> day of March A D 1863
