



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated at Philadelphia on the 15<sup>th</sup> Day of April Anno 1751 granted to Martin Chubb the above described Tract of Land Situate in Maccongy Township in the County of Northampton and Province of Pennsylvania Containing Twenty Acres and 25 Perches of Land together with the usual Allowance at six per Cent for Roads was Surveyed for the said Martin Chubb / Alias Shope / on the Third Day of September Anno 1753 - / The said Martin Chubb afterwards Sold his Place to Henry Geiss - / By order of M<sup>r</sup> William Parsons Esquire
