



The above is the Draught of 53^a of Land & allowance as usual which was Survey'd for Andrew M^o Dowell in the Year 1749. by my Father. in Pursuance of an Order Obtained by Robert Cather (which he transferred the Right of to Said M^o Dowell) bearing Date the 14th of January 1746 - lying near Octoraro Creek in Little Britain Township Lancaster County: At first there was 73^a & allowance included in the Survey by the Prick'd Lines at A & B but on the Complaint & Cause of J^o Hunter against the said Survey the Secretary Order'd the N 62° W Line (above Described) to be run as a Division Line between them & expressly directed the Land lying to the Southward thereof to be immediately Return'd for J^o Hunter which was accordingly done. Certify'd by Geo. Churchman D.S.

This Survey by Judgment of the Board of Property dated the 30th January 1769 is ordered to be Returned and Patented to Robt Cather -
