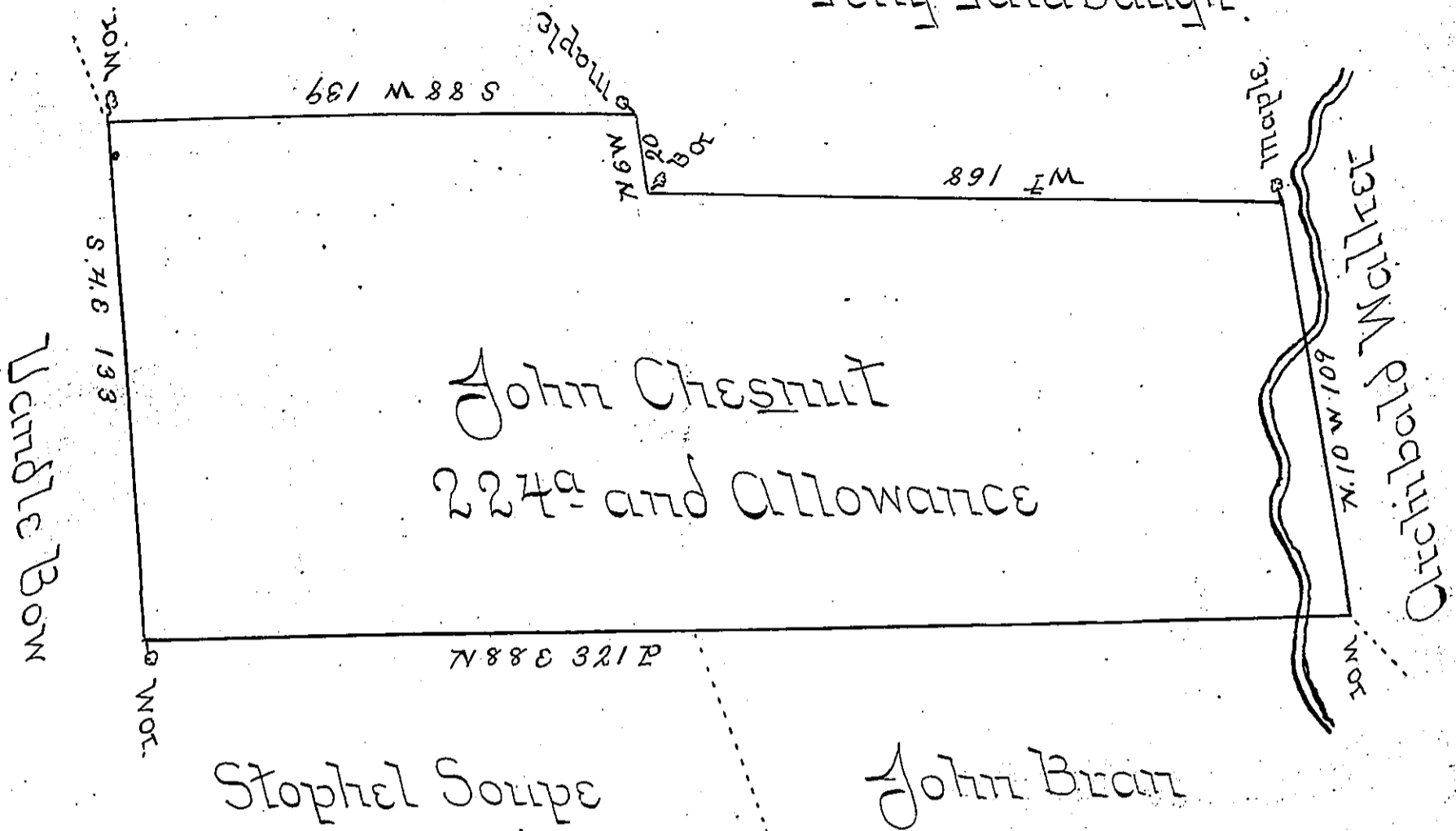


Felty Dalabaugh.
