



In Persuance of a Warrant for 400<sup>as</sup> dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of April 1793 was surveyed the 23<sup>d</sup> day of July 1818 for Edmund Bruce the above discribed tract of land containing 408<sup>as</sup> 27 perches and allowance of six per. Cent for Roads & C, - Situate on <sup>the</sup> waters of Shenang in fallow field Township Crawford County, and at the time of making said survey John Kline was Residing on the same - and there appeared to be - upwards of sixty acres Cleard fenced and in a good state of cultivation and that the same was devide by a North & south line as above stated John Kline 150<sup>as</sup> and allowance of the East End including his Improvements, & the Residue to ward Barney. —
