



Surveyed the above described tract of Land on the 30th day of September 1815 for Samuel Carpenter by Virtue of his Warrant Dated the 17th of July 1815, Containing thirty five Acres and Seventy two perch & allowance of Six percent for Roads & C, Situated on the Waters of Loyelsock Creek in Loyelsock Township Lycoming County, and bounded as above discribed, The improvements is a House with a famely residing therein & seven or Eight Acres Cleared Land, To Richard, T.
