In Pursuance of an Act of Assembly Passed the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1783 for the sale of Certain Lands therein Mentioned and by Virtue of a Commission to me directed under the hand and seal of Office of John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor General for the State of Pennsylvania bearing date at Philadelphia the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of August 1783 the above tract of Land containing two hundred six acres and twenty perches and allowance of 6 P<sup>er</sup> Cent for Roads &c.
