



Surveyed to John Clugh on the 10th day of January 1815 the above described tract of land containing Two hundred and Thirty acres & Thirty perches with an allowance of Six per Cent & c Situate on the waters of Toby's Creek N.E of the Allegeny river in Red bank Township Armstrong County - It being in pursuance of a warrant dated September 12th 1814 & N^o 6065 -

I do Certify that the Said John Clugh actually resides on the above described tract of land has a dwelling house and a barn there on erected has upwards of Twenty acres Cleared fenced & Cultivated on said tract - N.B. The above mentioned John Clugh Commenced his actual settlement on said tract prior to the 28th of March 1814.
