The above described Tract of land, Situation Turtle Creek. Including Th^o Small's Improvement, partly in Plumbe Township Allegheny Co^t & the residue in North Huntingdon Township Westmoreland County, Containing two hundred seventy three acres two rods eleven p^{ts} of a allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
