

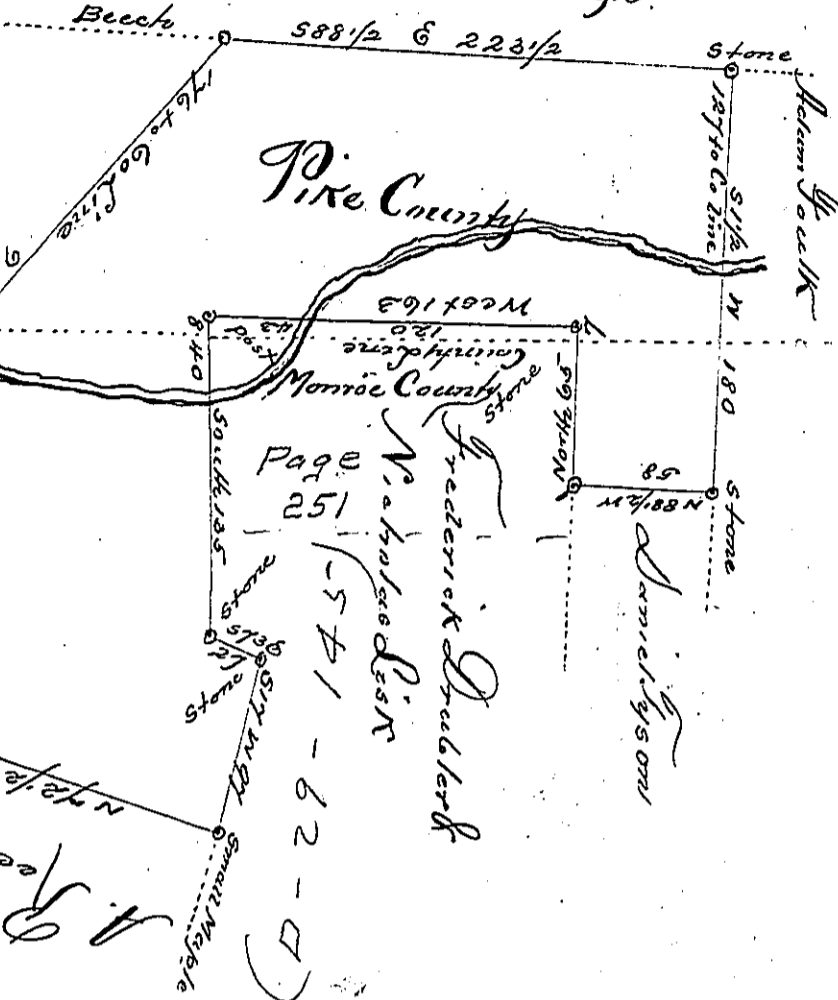

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 20 day of December, 1792 granted to Matthew
Conard, and an Order of Resurvey dated the 7 December 1858. Received
the 10 day of December, 1858. Surveyed the 24 day of December, 1858, the above,
tract of Land Situate partly in Monroe County Pike Township, and partly
in Greene Township in Pike County. Containing four hundred and twenty
one acres and thirty six perches, and the allowance of six per cent for
Roads &c.
