

By virtue of a Warrant dated the 20 day of December, 1792 granted to Matthew Carson, and an Order of Recurvey dated the 7 December 1858. Received ^{described} the 10 day of December 1858. Surveyed the 24 day of December 1858. The above, tract of Land Situate partly in Monroe County Price Township, and partly in Greene Township in Pike County. Containing four hundred and twenty one acres and thirty six perches, and the allowance of six per cent for Roads &c.
