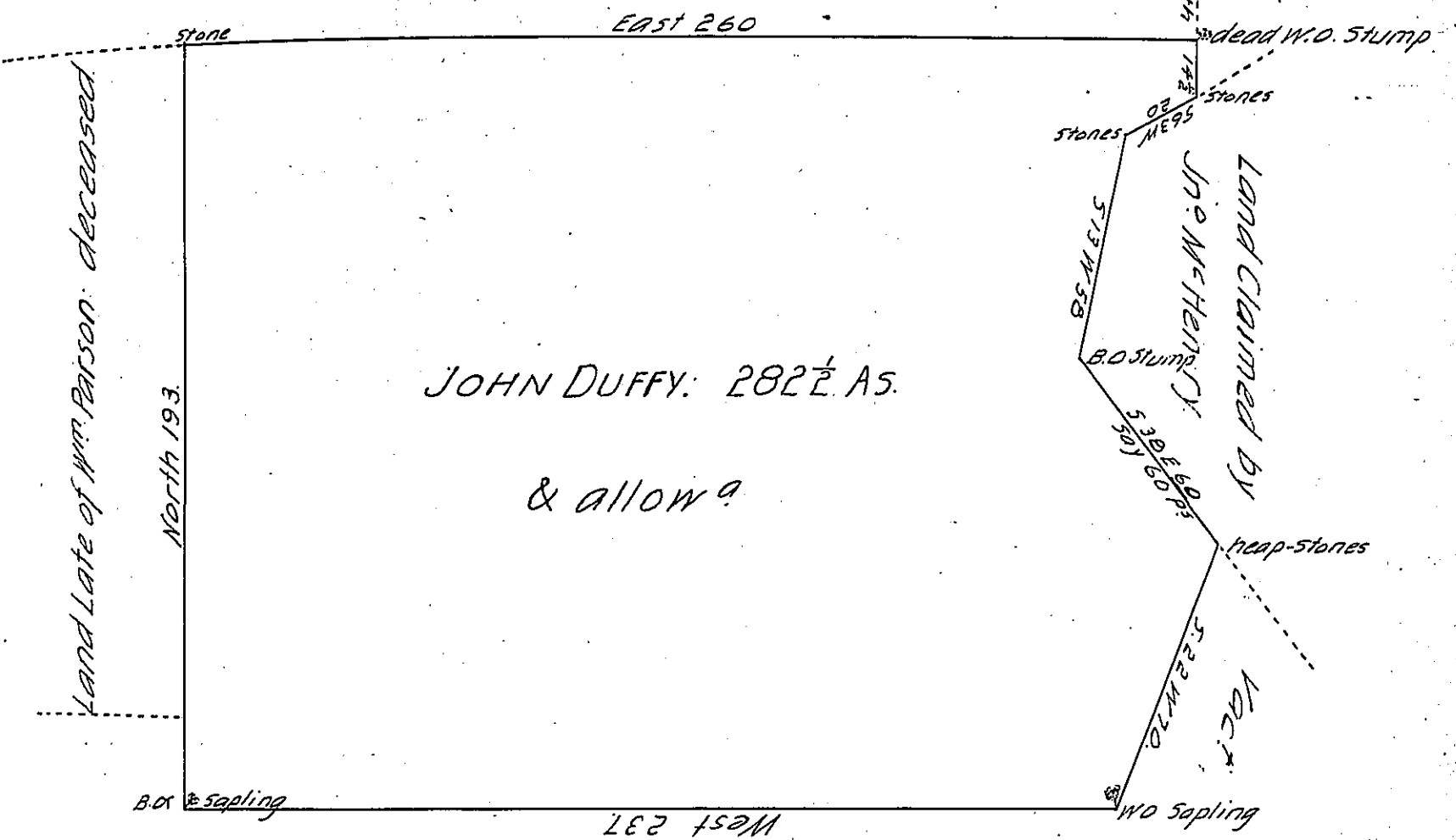

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 2<sup>d</sup> Day of February 1763. There was Surveyed  
 on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of August 1764. Unto John Duffy, the above described Tract of  
 Land Situate in West Pennsboro<sup>2</sup> Township in the County of Cumberland, Con-  
 taining 282 1/2 A<sup>s</sup> & allowance of Six acres P<sup>ct</sup> for Roads & Highways  
 P. Jno<sup>e</sup> Lukens 56.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in  
 the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made  
 conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of  
 February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused  
 the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg,  
 this eleventh day of June 1904.
