



In pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16th of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d of July following of a certain Lot of Ground in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland for Samuel Pearsons numbered in a General plan of said Town Eighty Eight containing in Breadth North and South Fifty Seven feet Six Inches and in length East and West Two hundred and thirty feet. Bounded Westward by the Broad Way, Northward by Lot Number Eighty Seven Eastward by River Alley, and Southward by Raspberry Alley. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 11th day of June 1773 for Margaret Duncan by Warrant dated the 2^d of January last.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirtieth day of June 1904.
