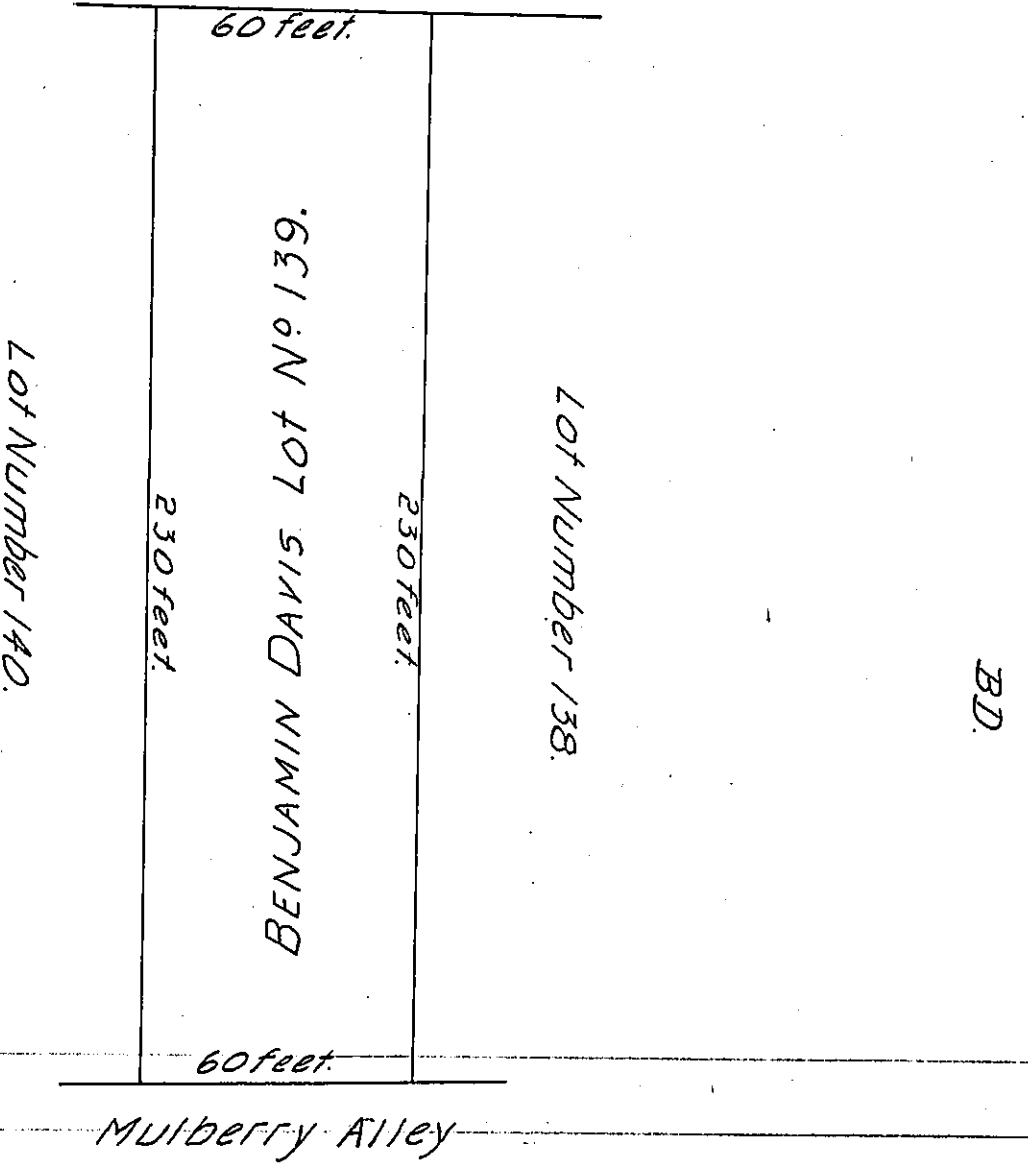


Dewberry Street.



In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioner of Property dated the 16<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3<sup>d</sup> day of July 1772 for Joseph Hudson on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town Number One hundred and Thirty Nine, Containing in Breadth East and West on the South side of Dewberry Street Sixty feet, and in Length North and South Two Hundred and Thirty feet, Bounded Northward by Dewberry Street, Eastward by Lot Number One Hundred and thirty Eight, Southward by Mulberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number One Hundred and forty. Returned into the Secretarys Office the 11<sup>th</sup> day of February 1775 for Benjamin Davis
