Being part of a larger Tract of 300 1/2 a &c of land which was Originally Surveyed by George Stevenson late D.S. on the 30<sup>th</sup> day of May A.D. 1752. In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to Jonas Chamberlain dated the 18<sup>th</sup> day of December A.D. 1757. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of January A.D. 1811 at the request of the owner William Atkinson who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation
