



The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 15th 1793 in pursuance of a Warrant Granted to Robert Elliot and Eli Williams for 400 Acres of Land Dated the fifteenth day of June 1792 (Situate North and West of the River Ohio Allegheny and Canawango Creek in Destrict No 9 in the County of Allegheny on the Waters ^{nearly opposite} of the two Mile run and Narrows Run) Called the Whirlpool Narrows, Containing four ^{the Lower part of Hamiltens Island} hundred and forty Acres with the Usual Allowance of 6 P^t Cent for Roads and highways
