

This Survey was originally Returned on a Warrant for 300^{as} and was filed in the Office the 18th May 1797, but at a meeting of the Board in August 1812 it was rejected and another survey ordered to be accepted on that Warrant. At another meeting of the Board held this Day (17th December 1812) this survey is now ordered to be returned on a Warrant for 200^{as} calling for land "upon a small branch of James Brady's saw mill run in Fairfield Township" Andrew Porter S.G.
