



Situate in Hellam Township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 48<sup>9</sup> & 146 Perches and the usual allowance &c. Being part of a larger Tract of 103<sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub><sup>9</sup> and allowance &c. which was originally surveyed by Charles Lukens late D.S. In Pursuance of an application No 1399 for 150<sup>9</sup>. Granted to the said Charles Lukens bearing date the 2<sup>d</sup> day of October A.D. 1766. Resurveyed by the old lines and divided off from the said larger Tract of Land on the 4<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1814 for and at the request of the Executors of the Estate of Baltzer Kunkle deceased, who desired the same to be returned for Confirmation the second day of June 1815
