



Situate near the South side of the Yaughiogoni River in Franklin Township Fayette County & surveyed the 7th day of March 1832 in pursuance of a warrant in the name of Francis Lewis for 150 acres of land dated the 7th day of May 1788.

There is 60 to 70 acres cleared, a log house & Barn, a few fruit trees, and a family residing on this tract. It appears as if the first improvement might be from 40 to 50 years old.
