In Pursuance of a warrant for 150<sup>9</sup> Granted to Daniel Devinney bearing date the first day of November A.D. 1784.

Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract of land for the present owner George Greenley the 19<sup>th</sup> day of February A.D. 1812. and at his request returned for Confirmation.
