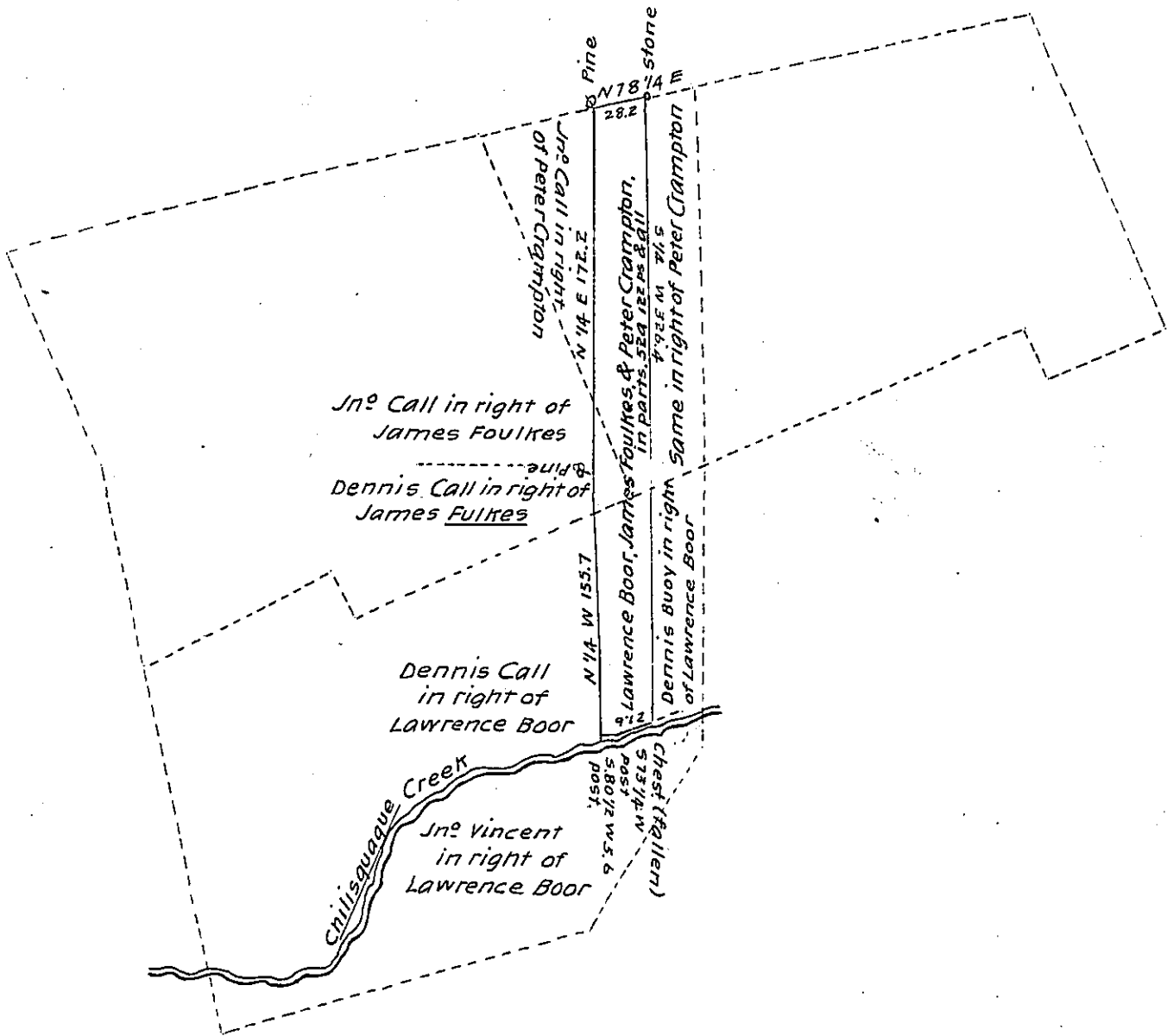


Cook Clayton & Thomas Pardoe



Situate in Chillisquaque township in the county of Northumberland, containing fifty two acres and one hundred and twenty two perches & the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c. (It being a part of three larger tracts of land; one of which was Surveyed by virtue of an application No 292, granted to Lawrence Boor, dated the \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_ 1769 containing 300 1/2 acres & allowance. Another of which was Surveyed in pursuance of application No 2049, dated the \_\_\_\_ granted to Peter Crampton day of \_\_\_\_ 1769, containing 294 acres & allowance - And the other thereof, Surveyed in pursuance of Application No 1368, dated the \_\_\_\_ day of \_\_\_\_ 1769, granted to James Foulkes, containing 307 acres & allowance &c.) Surveyed for Mr Peter Call the 24th day of October 1839.
