



In pursuance of a Warrant Dated January 8th 1814 No 6054 Granted to William Corbett was surveyed on the 15th day of January 1814 (as appears from a Warrant and Draught of Survey filed in the Office and the marks on the Ground) containing in all four hundred and thirty-five acres Ninety-six perches and allowance of six per cent &c Situate in (then) Redbank Township Armstrong County. And now "to Wit" on the 5th day of April 1839, resurveyed to Jacob McFaddin that part of the above Survey including ^{his} the name containing three hundred and twenty-six acres one hundred ten perches and allowance of six per cent & Situate in (now) Clarion Township Armstrong County.
