



The above Draught Exhibits the Boundaries of a Tract of Land the Property of Joseph Danice Situate in Lower Oxford Township in the County of Chester Containing 99 Acres, 106 Perches, and allowance of six per Cent, it being a part of a Tract of Land Containing 200 Acres of Land situated as above stated. And it appears that a certain James Cole, of the said County of Chester obtained a survey and Warrant Dated November 9th 1719 for the above mentioned 200 acres and allowance of six per Cent. The above 99 A. 106 p being by me surveyed this 24th day of November 1840.
