



Situate on the Waters of Licking Creek in Dublin township Bedford County containing 400 acres 58 perches and allowance of six per cent including Henry Flowers improvement now in the tenure of the said David Chessnut (which has been commenced about the year 1800) surveyed the 19<sup>th</sup> May 1840 and examined and corrected the 25<sup>th</sup> August 1840 on warrant dated the 18<sup>th</sup> July 1840 granted to the said David Chessnut for 400 acres.
