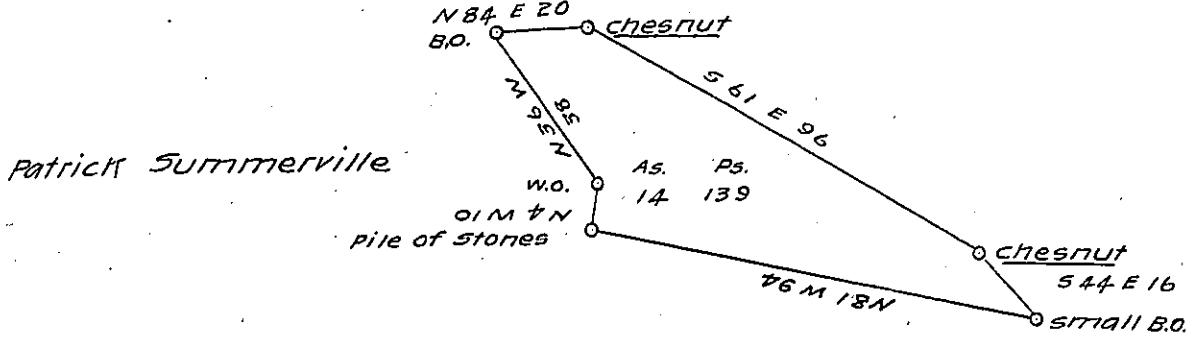

The above is a Draft of a tract of land situate on the waters of  
 Travis Creek on the south side of the Ohio River in Harrover Township.  
 Executed the 21st of June 1822 in pursuance of a warrant granted to  
 dated 28th May 1822  
 Samuel Conelly for sixteen acres of land, containing fourteen acres &  
 one hundred & thirty nine perches and the allowance of six per cent  
 for Roads &c.
