



In pursuance of a Warrant for 400<sup>as</sup> dated the 27th day of July A D 1815 was surveyed the 16th day of October 1816 the above discribed tract of Land for Jephtha Dunn Containing Four Hundred thirty one acres one hundred fifty six perches and Allowance of Six per cent, for Roads &c and at the time of making said survey David Dunn was in possession of the same, under the clame of the said Jephtha as a Tenant and there appered to be upwards of ten acres cleared and fenced and a house fit for the habitation of man. Situate in Venango township Crawford County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
