



In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 25th day of October AD. 1815 Was surveyed the 29th day of May A.D. 1817 for Neal Daugherty the above described tract of land containing four hundred one acre one hundred forty one perches & allowance of six pr. Cent for Roads &c. Situate in Part in Venango Township Crawford County and part in Coniouttee Township Erie County and at the time of making said survey Cornelias M<sup>c</sup>Bride was in Possession of the same under the said Neal Daugherty and there appered to be upwards of ten acres of the Land Cleared and fenced and a house fit for the habitation of man &c.
