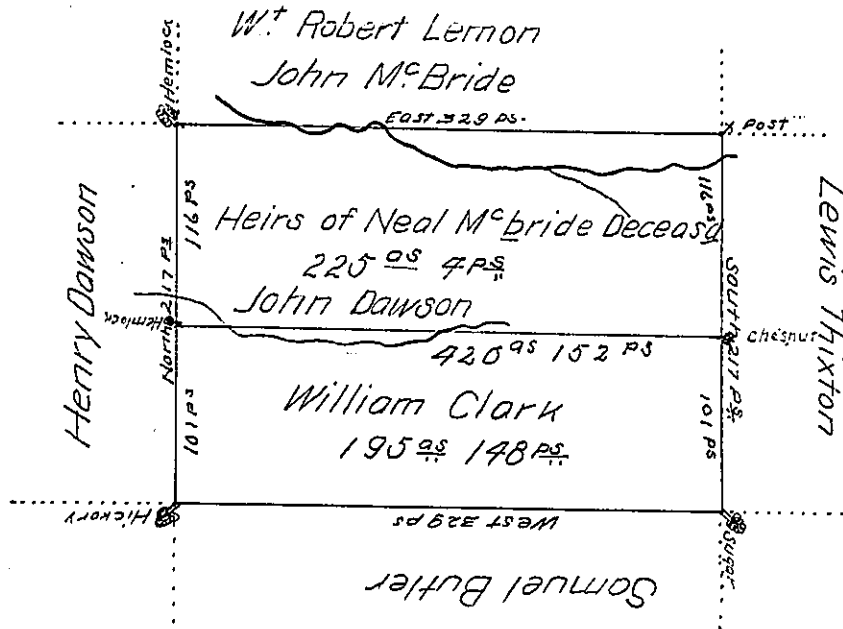

In persuance of Warrant for 400^{acs} of Land dated the 10th of April A.D. 1793 was surveyed the 3^d day of June A.D. 1817 for John Dawson the ^{above} described tract of Land Containing Four Hundred, twenty acres, one Hundred fifty two perches, and allowance of Six Per. Cent. for Roads &c. and that the same was Devided as above stated (by Consent) Between William Clark the Assignee of the said John Dawson and the Legal Heirs of the said Neal M^cBride Deceased- the said Heirs being of full age- and at the time of Making said survey the widow of the deceased & Heirs was in the actual Residant posesion of the same and had a house fit for the habitation of man and there appered to be upwards of fifteen acres of the Land clered fenced & in a good state of Cultivation and that the same is situate in Cassewago Township Crawford
