



Situate in Turbut township Northumberland County being part of a larger tract of land containing 295<sup>ac</sup> 6 & c. surveyed for James Mc Dermot on the 15<sup>th</sup> day of August 1772. In pursuance of an order of survey bearing date at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 5<sup>th</sup> day of July 1769. No. 3600 by W<sup>m</sup> Maclay then Deputy Surveyor, containing one hundred & twenty acres and thirty six perches & the usual all<sup>s</sup> of six per Cent & c. Resurveyed on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of March 1831.
