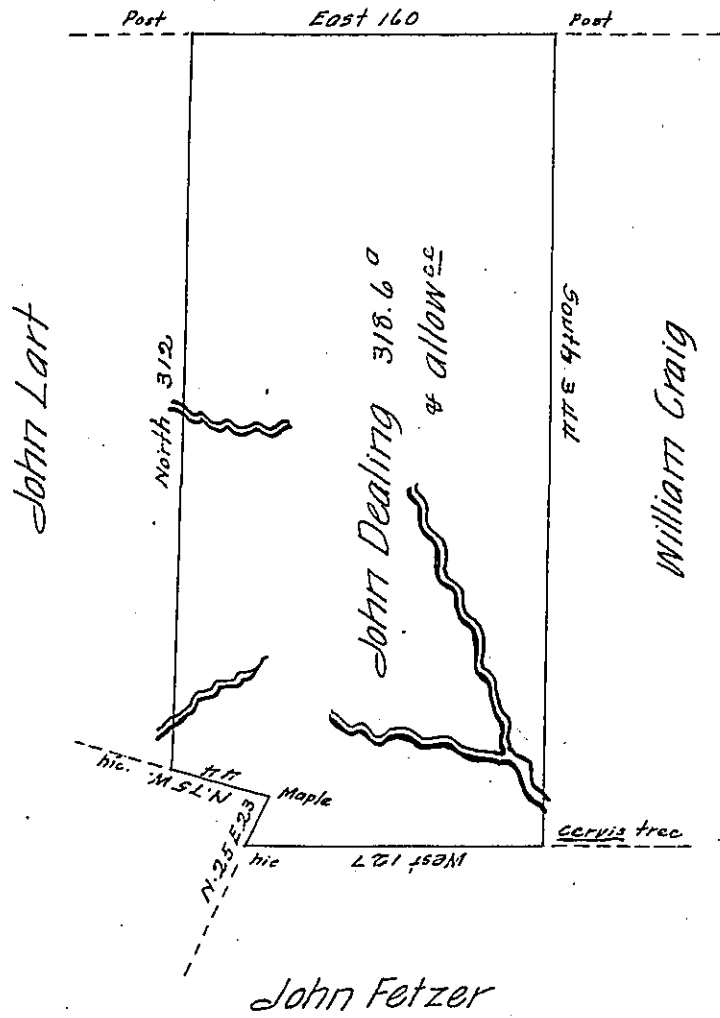

Survey to John Dealing on the 8th Day of November 1774. The above Described Tract of Three hundred & eighteen Acres & an half of an Acre & Allowance of six p. Ct situate on the Waters of Plum Creek including a spring which leads into said Creek & riseth about three Quarters of a Mile south Eastward from an Encamping Place of Benjamin Jacobs in Westmorland County. By Warrant of the 20th Day of January 1774.
