



Situate on the side of French Creek in Allegheny County Containing 401<sup>2/3</sup> 150<sup>2/3</sup> and Allowance of six pr Cent for Roads &c. Resurveyed the 4<sup>th</sup> day of May 1799. In persuance of a Warrant of 400<sup>2/3</sup> granted to James Dunlop, bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> May 1792. [It being the same tract of land which was surveyed the 2<sup>nd</sup> June 1795, for Joseph Marshall on his improvement dated 15<sup>th</sup> May 1795.
