



Situate on the waters of Little Sandy Creek in Henry Clay township Fayette County, & surveyed the 5th day of June 1835. In pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Jeremiah Day for 400^{ac} dated the 10th day of February 1794

There is about 15^{ac} cleared, a cabbⁿ house, barn Smith shop and a family residing on this tract and has been improved about 15 years
