



A Draught of land situate in Lack Township Mifflin (Formerly Cumberland) county containing sixty nine acres and seventy three perches and allowance &c. being part of 302,4 acres, appears to have been surveyed to Stephen Porter by Virtue of an Order of Survey No. 1850 dated at Philadelphia the 5<sup>th</sup> day of Nov<sup>r</sup> 1766, and resurveyed and divided to Thomas Dobbs Jun<sup>r</sup> by W<sup>m</sup> Harris D. S. the 29<sup>th</sup> October 1802. Examined 2<sup>nd</sup> May 1822.
