



Situate on the West side of French Creek in Allegheny County containing 401 acres 150^{ac} and allowance of 6 per cent for roads &c. Resurveyed the 13th July 1799. In pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thos. Dobson bearing date the 30th May 1792. It being the same tract of land which was surveyed the 2nd June 1795, for John Wallace on his Improvement dated June 1st 1795.
