Situate in Windsor (late York) Township in the County of York containing as above set forth five Acres One hundred and thirty three perches & allowance of six per cent for roads & ca. Being part of a larger tract of 139²⁵ & allowance Originally surveyed by George Stevenson Esqr late D. S. on the 21st day of April A. D. 1753. In pursuance of a Warrant for ———²³ granted to Jacob Durkey dated the 5th day of May A. D. 1752. The above part resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 4th day of August A. D. 1800. And now at the request of Martin Slenker the present owner of said part, the same is examined, corrected and returned for confirmation ——— 19th April 1822.
