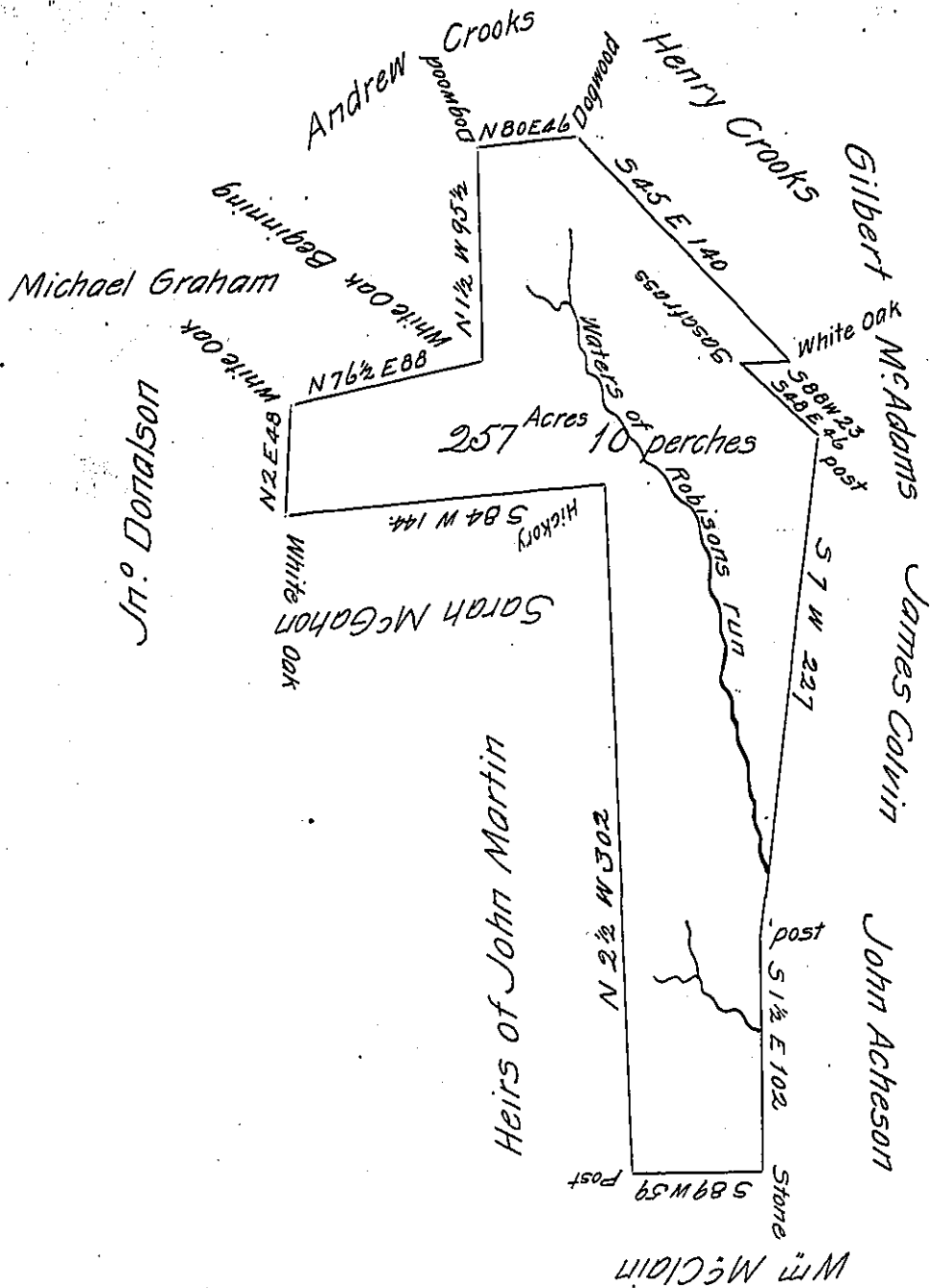


Accepted 15th March 1802.
