



The above is a Draft of a Tract of Land which was Surveyed to Thomas Christy on the 23^d day of June 1804 by Virtue of his Warrant dated the 20th day of April 1804 Containing four Hundred & twenty Seven Acres and 61 perches and Allowance of Six per Cent &c Including his Actual Settlement and Improvement Situate on the Waters of Conoquenessing Creek in Conoquenessing Township and Butler County To Samuel Cochran Esquire Ja^s Irvine D.S. Surveyor General of Pennsylvania
