



A Draft of a tract of land situated in Wright township formerly Hanover township in Luzerne County adjoining lands surveyed to G.W. Woodward and others containing altogether three hundred eighty-five acres and allowance of six per cent &c &c out of which amount George Carey and Eleazer Carey claim one hundred fifty three acres and three-fourths of an acre and allowance of six percent &c &c in manner as shown by the closed part of the above draft and upon which said 153 3/4^{ac} &c are four dwelling houses with their respective contiguous improvements and cleared and cultivated lots of land The first house was built and the first clearing done about A.D. 1841

By virtue of a Warrant dated November 10th 1857 surveyed the above described tract of land to Adam Diller the sixteenth and seventeenth days of December A.D. one thousand eight hundred and fifty seven subject however to all the preemption rights of the settlers upon the said 153 3/4^{ac} &c
