



Surveyed to John Dick and Samuel Wallace on the 3<sup>d</sup> of November 1815 the above described tract of two hundred and four acres and one hundred and twenty four perches and allowance of six per cent &c. including an improvement situate adjoining John Shaver on the south George Findley on the North Adam Sides and others on the West, in Wheatfield Township Indiana County.
