



By Virtue of a warrant from the Hon^{ble} Propriet^y Dated the first Day of November
 anno Domⁱ 1735. There is Survey'd unto Alex^{es} Frazier Two hundred acres
 of Land with allowance of 6 p-Cent in Lancaster County on the west side -
 Susquehannah River; and Begins at a Hickory by Yellow Breeches Creek,
 Thence South Tenn Degrees westerly ^{Two hundred & Sixty p-} to a Hickory by the 5^d Creek. Then Trav-
 ersing Down the Severall Courses of the 5^d Creek: about five hund-and-
 seventy pches to the place of Beginning
