



The Above is a Draught of a Tract Land Situate on the Waters of Buffalo Creek, Cal<sup>d</sup> Jealousy Containing one hundred and forty three and three fourths Acres. Surveyed February the 2<sup>d</sup> 1786 in pursuance of the Hereto annexed Certificat Granted to Ezekiel Boggs by the Commissioners for the state of Virginia.

Viz; We the Commissioners appointed for adjusting the Claims to unpatented land in the Counties of Monongahalea, Yohoganea and Ohio do Hereby Certify that Ezekiel Boggs is intituled to Two hundred acres of land in the County of Ohio on the Waters of Buffalo Creek to includ his Settlement made in the Year of our Lord 1774.

Given under our hands at Redstone old fort this twenty second day of November 1779 in the fourth year of the Commonwealth
