A Draught of one hundred and ten acres and one hundred and thirty eight perches of land with six per cent for roads, situated formerly in Cumberland County, now in Millford township in Mifflin County, which is part of a survey made in pursuance of a Warrant to William Devin and George White, dated 1st March, 1755, said to contain 204¹/₂ ac. but found to contain 205¹/₂ ac. 44 perches with 6 pr. Cent. Resurveyed and divided 26th March 1791, as appears by official papers remaining in my Office. Re-surveyed, in part, and examined 10th June 1812.
