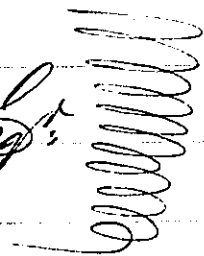


A draught of a track of land called \_\_\_\_\_ Situate in the County of Luzerne,
