



A Plan of a lot of ground situate on the West side of George Street in the Town of York No 67 containing in Breadth on the said Street $7\frac{1}{2}$ feet and on half and in length to a twenty feet Alley two hundred $7\frac{1}{2}$ feet bounded Eastward with the said street Southward with a lot of ground No 68 Westward with a twenty feet Alley and Northward with a lot of ground No 66 entered on the Plan of the sd Town and surveyed for Martin Ebert who has built an House on the same according to the Conditions of settling the Town - Certified at York the 1st April 1754 -
