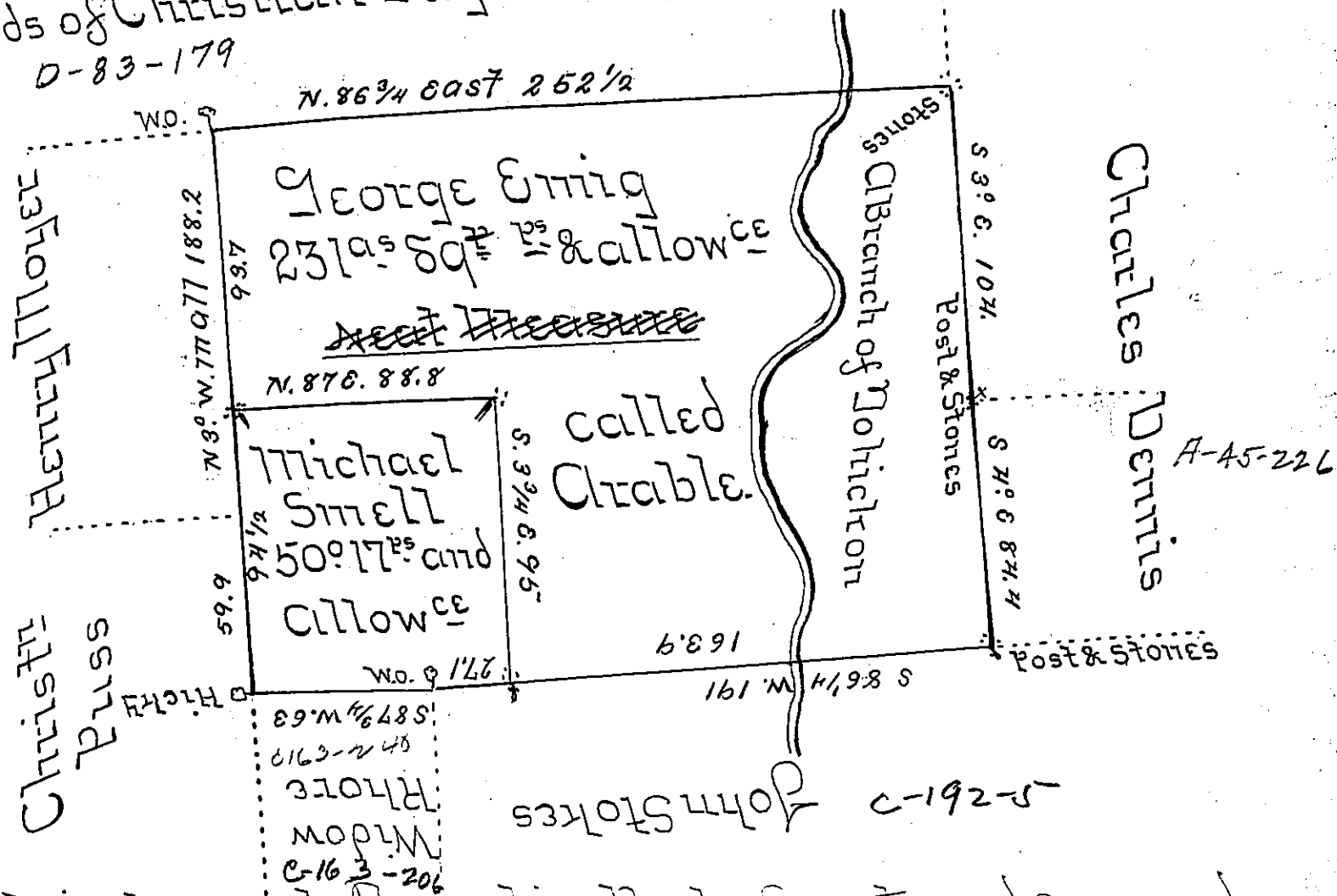

Situate in Haycock Township, Bucks County, and surveyed by Order, the 20th Day of April Anno Domini 1765 PE



I have joined a Draught of Michael Smell's Land to that of Emig at their joint Request. The said Emig assuring me that as it was part of the same Tract he would see the whole cleared at the same Time. The said Smell bot the Imp^t Right of Emig. Wm. July 6, 1768

As to the Value of the above described Land I know not what to say; but if it be compared with other Lands that have been lately sold under the same Circumstances, in the Neighbourhood, a Price in Proportion may be nearly fixed on so that at whatever Rate Solomon Gumber & others adjoining him obtained their Lands the Land above described might justly be rated a higher something as it exceeds those Lands both in Quality and Situation -
